Dear [REDACTED],

As part of the effort to keep everyone safe this fall, the university administration is requiring random testing for BYU faculty, staff, and students. You have been selected to participate in this week's testing. This testing helps us draw a clear picture of the overall health of the BYU community over time.

This will be a saliva test, not a nasal swab.

To protect your safety as well as that of the healthcare professionals, please follow these steps for your COVID-19 test:

1. Please complete your test by Wednesday, September 9, 2020
2. To get the test, please go to the BYU Risk Management Building (RMB). The street address is 795 N. 500 E. Provo, UT. This is located just south of the botany pond, near the Life Sciences Building (LSB).
3. DO NOT eat or drink for 30 minutes before the test.
4. Please bring your Driver's License or BYU ID
5. Please do not report for testing if you are symptomatic, or have been asked to isolate or quarantine.
6. Please be prepared to show a daily_passport in the Healthy Together app (using the passport tab), or complete the online passport form, or print and complete a blank form.
7. Choose one time below to walk-in for testing. No appointment is necessary.
 - a. Tuesday, September 8, 2020 from 9:00-4:00 p.m.
 - b. Wednesday, September 9, 2020 from 9:00-4:00 p.m.
8. There will be no charge for this screening test.
9. Wear a mask until instructed to remove it for testing.
10. Test results will be shared with you via email or phone call from the university.
11. Test results will also be shared with local and/or state health departments in a confidential and secure manner.

Please complete your required testing as soon as possible. As President Worthen says in the video <https://welcome-back.byu.edu/video/>, it is "critical that you read and adhere to the information found on the BYU coronavirus updates website and the information and requirements outlined in this training." This random screening/testing is one of the important efforts to keep us all safe and have campus open.
